Section 2 Course Objectives and Components

1. Course objectives:

1) Explain the philosophy, concepts, basic principles, scope of work in mental health, concepts, and the history of mental health and psychiatric nursing, the role and characteristics of psychiatric nurses the roles of nurses in caring for individuals, risk groups, those with mental health problems, psychiatric problems, and drug addiction in community and in institution.

- 2) Analyze the differences, causes, and symptoms between individuals with mental health issues and those suffering from psychiatric disorders, and understand the principles of differential diagnosis in mental health and psychiatry.
- 3) Explain the principles of nursing for individuals with cognitive, emotional, perceptual, and behavioral disorders, including controlling the consumption of tobacco and addictive substances, by using a holistic nursing process that considers morality, ethics, and multiculturalism in community.
- 4) Using nursing process, mental health and psychiatric screening and assessment tools, mental health and psychiatric nursing technologies, counseling and psycho-social therapy in patients with psychiatric problems and therapeutic relationship with regard to laws, the code of ethics and professional conduct.

2. Course description:

Basic principles, concepts of cognitive development theories, psychosocial theories, the role of nurse in promotion, prevention, therapeutic care, and rehabilitation for those with mental health and psychiatric problems throughout the lifespan, tobacco control in community and health care setting based on patient's rights, mental health acts, ethics, and professional code of ethics, laboratory practice using nursing process, psychiatric screening and assessment tools, therapeutic use of self, counseling, therapeutic relationship, group activities, and mental health and psychiatric nursing information technology.

Re-examination (การสอบแก้ตัว)

Students who have score (%) less than 60% form 100%, he/she will be received opportunity to reexamination. Reexamination by multiple choices, the score results maximum no more than C level.

Student Appeal (การอุทธรณ์ของนักศึกษา)

Student can ask the course coordinator for review his/her test results and grade. He/she also can ask for reconsider the score result or the grade if needed within 1 week after known the results.

If there is a student ask for review like above paragraph, student have to complete a student appeal form and send the completed form to the head of mental health and psychiatric nursing group via the course coordinator. The course coordinator have to present the student appeal in the course instructors meeting and report the progression to the head of mental health and psychiatric nursing group. The course coordinator also inform the reconsideration results to the student within 1 month.
